



Dear Calvary Family –

We are living in uncertain and fast-changing times. With recent updates from the state and after meeting with Church leadership, we have made the decision to honor the requests of our government about gathering as groups.

Beginning today, March 18 and lasting until at least April 1, Calvary will not have any Wednesday or Sunday evening groups/programming on campus for any and all age groups. There will be no on-site Sunday School as well, and we have also made the tough but prayerful decision to have only live-stream worship for the Sunday morning services. This will allow for the praise team, soloists, and Pastors to get together with the Audio/Visual team and live-stream the service while still remaining under the 50 person recommended limit. This service will be both live-streamed at 10:30 AM on Sunday, and available by DVD to any member for free delivery upon request. There will be availability to interact with the Pastors and other members during the stream, ask for prayer requests, and to give on-line both during the Sunday stream and any other time through the website at www.discovercalvary.org.

We have upgraded our church website and software this week to allow us to have Sunday School lessons for every age group. Additionally, Chris Clegg will preach a GSM message, Melanie Roberts will lead a children's lesson, and Megan Saville will do a ladies' Bible study on-line as well that can be accessed in a simple manner at any time. While our ministry team of staff and deacons will continue to minister to our members in every way, the Church Office will open only on Mondays and Wednesdays and can be accessed only through the office doors. We will also cancel any and all church activities and programs over the next two weeks that would utilize the church facilities or vehicles during this period. Our buildings will be closed, and sections locked off, as our custodial crew is working hard to clean and disinfect all portions of our facility. Anyone entering those areas will compromise that cleaning process.

Please remember that Calvary relies on your faithful giving to carry out our mission and ministries. We ask that you continue to support the Church by continuing to give. You can mail tithes and offerings to the Church, drop them by the Church Office on Monday or Wednesdays, or you can now E-Give directly using the service on the website.
